Peaslake Village Community Fund

The Peaslake Village Community Fund was established with a capital sum from a bequest to the Peaslake Community Council by Miss Jean Brodie. Interest generated by the Fund will be used each year to pay for a Christmas lunch for the elderly of Peaslake and other good causes.

Additional donations to the Fund will be sought from fundraising activities and donations from local residents to enable the capital to grow over time. The Peaslake Community Council will recommend to the Surrey Community Foundation the award of grants from the income generated.

Donations to the Peaslake Village Community Fund can be made at any level – as gifts or legacies of cash, shares, property or land. This can be tax efficient for donors – a Gift Aid form and contact details for the Surrey Community Foundation are printed on the back of this leaflet, for those wishing to make a donation.

Aims

The aim is to provide the village of Peaslake with a sustainable source of funding that will, over time, make a significant contribution to meeting the charitable needs of the community.

The key objectives are:

- to create a permanent source of community capital to support and benefit community projects, voluntary groups and needy residents in Peaslake and the surrounding area;
- and to establish a capital sum of at least £100,000 to enable approximately £6,000 to be generated each year in perpetuity, to award as grants.
