**D222 PEASLAKE LANE, PEASLAKE**  
**EMERGENCY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC NOTICE 2009**

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL IN EXERCISE OF ITS POWERS UNDER SECTION 14 (2) OF THE Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers hereby gives notice that:

No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed along that length of D0222 Peaslake Lane, between its junctions with Mackies Hill and Radnor Road, Peaslake.

Access for emergency vehicles and residents will be allowed where possible. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The prohibition referred to above will also not apply in respect of anything done –

- a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden
- b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Surrey Police

This Notice is necessary to facilitate the safety of the public during excavation works in the verge and carriageway on behalf of British Telecommunications Plc. It is anticipated that the closure will be required for a period of one day and will commence on 12 October 2009, but this period may be extended by the County Council if required, for up to 21 days.

The diversion route for all other traffic will be via Walking Bottom, Lawbrook Lane, Burrows Cross, Pursers Lane and vice versa.
