#### **Welcome & Introduction**

<u>Peaslake Cemetery Fence:</u> A consultation with residents showed a preference for metal fencing (17 responses) over wooden palisade fencing (14 responses), with no support for a post-and-rail option. The group discussed the merits of both remaining options, and it was agreed to obtain detailed quotes for both palisade and estate-style metal fencing. Kate Denny will also investigate the expected lifespan and guarantee on the wooden posts before they are likely to rot.

The Mega Quiz to raise funds for the fence was very well attended and huge fun. Congratulations to the winning team from Walking Bottom and a huge thank you to the brilliant quizmaster – Richard Sherlock.

<u>Official Opening of The Studio at Peaslake Village Hall:</u> The new extension at Peaslake Village Hall, known as *The Studio*, officially opens on 22 November. This modern, versatile space is now available for hire and offers an ideal setting for business meetings, team awaydays, classes, interviews, or use as dressing rooms for theatre productions in the main hall. Modern, adaptable, and thoughtfully designed, The Studio is ready to support a wide range of activities and events.

Alongside the official opening there is a **Winter Warmer** event. Doors open 10.30. Lots of Christmas gifts, tea,coffee, cake, mulled wine and mince pies available. Kiddie pot luck, create a bauble, raffle, antique fair. bric-a-brac, paintings and prints from a local artist, crocheted hand made gifts and more.
