MAGGIE'S WALKS - PEASLAKE WALKING ROUTES



Walks round Peaslake for you to undertake! The walks are mainly over footpaths, sometimes crossing over stiles and farmland, or through the woods and over tracks in the Surrey Hills. Extensive views to the North Downs or South Downs can be enjoyed.

Each walk takes one and a half or two hours to complete

Starting Point: Hurtwood Inn, Peaslake

<u>Walks 1 & 2</u>: 1-1 % hours A circular walk to 'the top of Peaslake' with views to the North Downs. The walk crosses over undulating fields, over styles, through pretty lanes and past attractive houses.

<u>Walk 3:</u> A Circular Walk from Peaslake Stores onto Holmbury Hill: 1 hr 25 mins. Walk from the stores, into woods, along quiet lanes and over farmland to reach Holmbury Hill. Then return through ancient woodland to Peaslake.

<u>Walk 4:</u> Holmbury Hill (2 hours) — a circular though undulating hills to the top of the Hill. Walk through the woods and along sandy tracks to reach a 'trig point' and information boards. The remains of an Iron Age Fort can also be seen. **Spectacular views stretch to the South Downs, with a glimpse of the sea on a clear day.**

<u>Walk 5:</u> Circular Walk to Winterfold Forest: 2 hours. An interesting walk towards Farley Green, taking walkers over footpaths and fields with open views, then down a narrow bridle track and along a footpath, before passing vines to enter Winterfold Forest.

<u>Walk 6:</u> Circular walk round Pitch Hill: 2 hours. Walking directly from the Hurtwood Inn and behind the pretty St Mark's church to climb to the top of Pitch Hill. The hill is 834 feet above sea level. Views from the top of the Hill allow you see the Weald of Surrey and Sussex as far as the English Channel - a distance of more than 25 miles.
